



Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What is the deposit amount for an event?** A \$500 damage deposit as well as a signed contract are required to hold the date(s) you request. The deposit is refundable within 10 business days after your event, should no damages occur. In the event of cancellation, the deposit will not be refunded to you.
- 2. When is the balance due?** A \$500 damage deposit as well as a signed contract are required at the time of booking to hold your date(s). 50% of the balance must be paid three months prior to the event. The remaining balance is due one month prior to the event.
- 3. Can I make payments?** Yes
- 4. Can we bring alcohol?** No, you can however contact The Tippy Travelers for bar packages and explanation of the bar packages; Megan 319-201-0470.
- 5. Can I bring a pet?** No. However, service animals are allowed.
- 6. Does Whitetail Country Estates have ice?** Yes, 20 lb pre-packaged bags are available to purchase for \$6 per bag. Prices are subject to change.
- 7. Can we use artificial rose petals to drop on the ground?** No, we do not allow confetti or any other artificial products. You may use natural flower petals or birdseed.
- 8. Can we come early to decorate or bring items?** Yes, the package includes access to the property from 8:00 am- 8:00pm Thursday and Friday for decorating.
- 9. Can we use real candles?** No, only battery operated candles.
- 10. Can I leave paper products and food inside the Rehearsal Hall or Vintage Barn overnight?** Paper products and food are not allowed to be left in the Rehearsal Hall or Vintage Barn overnight. You may store food inside our refrigerator at the Rehearsal Hall if needed. We do not have any containers for leftovers, so remember to plan accordingly.
- 11. Can we host an after-party in the Whitetail Lodge?** No. We understand that sometimes people like to keep the party going, but your wedding night is for you and your spouse. For that reason, we enforce a strict midnight curfew. Any mishaps past this hour will be reported to the police.
